The College of the Florida Keys' National Council Licensure Examination (NCLEX) pass rates are a critical indicator of program quality and student readiness, reflecting the College's commitment to academic excellence and workforce preparedness. These outcomes align with the Florida College System's Strategic Plan, which emphasizes the importance of student success and licensure. The table below presents the outcomes of The College of the Florida Keys' Associate in Science in Nursing (ASN) program highlighting the NCLEX pass rates. These rates are compared to both state and national averages, providing a comprehensive view of our program's effectiveness in preparing nursing students for licensure.
