



2024-2025 Unusual Enrollment History Petition

U.S. Department of Education has established new regulations to prevent fraud and abuse in the Federal Pell Grant Program by identifying students with unusual enrollment histories. Some students who have an unusual enrollment history have legitimate reasons for their enrollment at multiple institutions. However, such an enrollment history requires a review to determine whether there are valid reasons for the unusual enrollment history. This must be resolved before you can receive financial aid.

- Appeals submitted without sufficient supporting documentation will be denied without an option to resubmit
- DO NOT include original records, they will NOT be returned. DO ensure all copies are legible.

A. Student Information

C. Student Information

If you answered "no" to the Credit Hours Earned question for any of the schools you attended in the **2020-2021**, **2021-2022**, **2022-2023** and **2023-2024**. You must provide an explanation of your failure to earn academic credit and provide third party documentation to support your explanation.

- Death of an immediate family member (you must include the relationship of the family member and a copy of the death certificate)
- Documented hospitalization or illness of self, child, or parent (must include dates and a heath care provider's decision, written on official letterhead of the student's readiness to return to school)
- Military obligations (must include documentation from commanding officer)
- > Victim of a crime or unexpected disaster (must include copy of police report, third-party letters, etc.)

D. Petition Documentation

Additional documents that MUST BE included:

- Letter explaining your past enrollment history. This document must be signed and dated. *
- Copies of unofficial transcripts for all institutions in which you have earned credits you listed in section 2. *
