"CTE is direct training that you can immediately apply to a job," says Mrs. Hughes. "The options for CTE courses at the Academy include the Digital Media Foundations class, in which students learn about Adobe Premiere and After Effects, Entrepreneurship, Principles of Biomedical Sciences, and Aerospace Engineering." There are also several options of CTE courses that dual-enrollment (DE) students can take at the college including: Welding, Engine Repair, Marine Tech, Scuba Diving, Boat Mechanics, Medical and Nursing Sciences, among other options. Other information that Mrs. Hughes would like to share regarding CTE would be to, "Let your interests be known," and, "There is definitely something out there for you." Ms. Huebscher recommends that students explore the college website if they want to see the many options for classes they can take. She also said that any DE student can participate in apprenticeship opportunities from experts in the field of their choice. In the fall semester, students can choose to do Electrical or Carpentry and in the spring semester they can choose between HVAC and Plumbing.

# Team Building a






