Criteria:

- Be a graduating senior from a high school in Key West
- Plan to pursue a bachelor's degree in the field of education at an accredited public college or university in Florida
- Have a 2.5 or higher high school GPA
- Maintain a 2.5 or higher college GPA
- Have a Student Aid Index of \$30,000 or less as determined by the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)
- Not be a child or grandchild of a member of the Rotary Club of Key West
- Complete and submit this application, including essay, reference letters, and Student Aid Index documentation, by the **deadline of Monday, March 24** to the respective high school guidance counselor.
